What's on top in Ruru Iti? We are all settling in so well, getting to know all the routines of school and making new friends. We have started our Literacy programme last week with reading and writing in our yellow and blue books and will start maths this week. Handwriting is a focus so there is a copy of the letter formations at the end of this document. We are also beginning our Inquiry (Mahi Rangahau) looking at Beneath the Surface with a focus on Papatūānuku.

What's on top in Ruru Nui?

We have had a wonderful first couple of weeks settling in. We have spent time re-establishing routines, reconnecting with old friends and making new ones. We have started our literacy programme with reading, writing and The Code. Our maths programme has started with daily number knowledge and investigating 2D and 3D shapes.
